Summary

This study has tackled the privatization issue in terms of sharia'a position, legislation's and regulations that basically emerged from "Quran" and "Hadith" Texts.

Within this perception, the researcher managed to define privatization as "The transition of public acquisition rights to the private sector or individuals, provided, statehood control is respected".

Moreover, the study brought to light the state role and involvement in the economy, besides, the development, risks, implications, advantages and disadvantages of privatization.

The Islamic Legislation supported dual ownership whether it was private or public, where for each of them several advantages that can serve the national economic and social infrastructure with optimum feasibility, motivating innovation and productivity and fair distribution of resources.

Public propriety ship rights abandonment or transition should not whatsoever jeopardize public interests, and it can be reinstated in case of abuse or public interests are dishonored.
